ICPS TRAINING

The **International Crime Prevention Specialist (ICPS) Training and Testing** will be offered before the Symposium. **The ICPS Training and Testing is \$275.00.** The ICPS training will be held Monday, March 22-Wednesday March 24, 2010.

This training is designed to give participants a “crash course in crime prevention.” It will not make you an instant expert - crime prevention expertise takes years of practice and study.

The class is taught by experienced ISCPP trainers who have 10-35 years of crime prevention experience. Each attendee will learn the 15

SPECIAL EVENTS

There are two major events that take place at every ISCPP Symposium:
